Remaining equipment is managed by Academic Computing Services (ACS), which accounts for virtually all undergraduate use and approximately 2/3 of graduate student use. Excludes an estimated additional 10% of stations at the Rady School of Management, School of Medicine, School of Pharmacy, and Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

(1a.) Includes both print and electronic formats.

(2) Workstations provided and maintained by UCSD Libraries IT Department.

(3) With over 60,000 active internet addresses, 99.9999% of all computers at UCSD are on the network.
